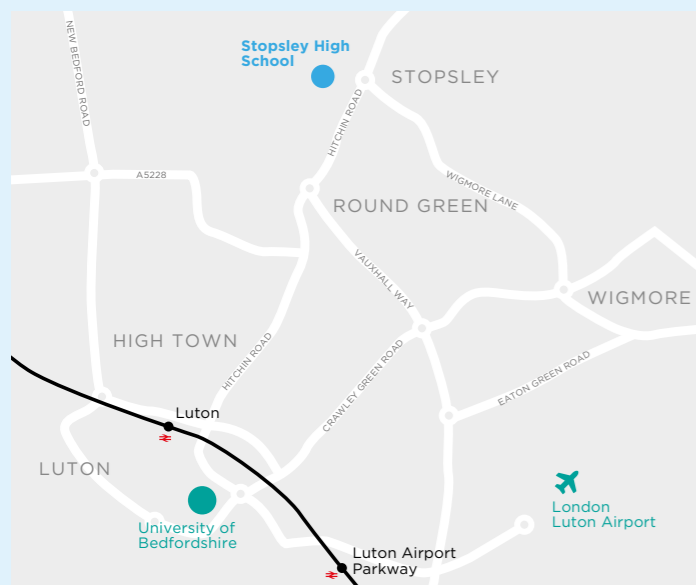


A favourable location
