A reminder: we have a "not seen in school" mobile phone policy. Mobile phones should not be out at any time in school and should remain in school bags, switched off during the school day. This includes break and lunch times.

	Scientific Calculator	


The strength of our policies lies in our consistent application in school, and your support at home; if we fall short in either case, our policies are rendered less effective.
