



Creating Tomorrow Multi Academy Trust is opening Windmill Hill School on York Street, Luton in September 2021.

Windmill Hill School will initially take up to 50 students (aged 11-19) with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities, rising to a capacity of 120 by 2024.

The School will be a state-funded, special free school with the aim of preparing students to be confident, successful and responsible citizens in our ever changing world.

Creating Tomorrow Multi Academy Trust is a partnership currently of three special schools and one Specialist Post-16 Institute. The Trust has a reputation for supporting some of the most vulnerable young people in our communities into independence in adulthood.

As part of the pre-opening work to become a free school, the Trust is completing a formal consultation exercise (as set out in Section 10 of the Academies Act, 2010) to determine whether they should enter into a Funding Agreement with the Department for Education, pending approval of the Secretary of State.
