## Headteacher's Letter



Dear all,

I am delighted to share with you all that having now completed our second full week back at school our students have continued to impress us with their Top Class attitude to learning but also the respect and consideration that they give to one another makes me very proud indeed.

Thank you for supporting us at the beginning and the end of the school day with a safe and calm entry and exit. As a polite reminder, if you are dropping off or collecting your children by car please ensure that you drive into the allocated dropping off point to avoid congestion of traffic making it unsafe for children entering and exiting the school. You will see staff directing cars to where it is safe to wait but if you can arrange to collect your children a short distance from the school this will be greatly appreciated. We are also controlling the flow of students out of the gate at the end of the day so that it is a safe and steady flow.
