



# Candidate Consent Form for Review of Marking

The following information explains what may happen following a review of marking and any subsequent appeal.

If your school submits a request for a review of the original marking, and then a subsequent appeal, for one of your examinations after your subject grade has been issued, there are three possible outcomes:

- Your original mark is lowered, so your final grade may be lower than the original grade you received.
- Your original mark is confirmed as correct, so there is no change to your grade.
- Your original mark is raised, so your final grade may be higher than the original grade you received.

To proceed with the review of marking, you **must** sign the form below. This tells your school that you have understood what the outcome might be, and that you give your consent for the review of marking being submitted.
